Longer Combination Vehicles (LCV) Course

Course Pre-requisites: 150,000 km (or 24 months) driving experience on articulated vehicles

To obtain a certificate to operate LCVs, drivers must complete the PDIC course, the 4 hour LCV training course (including driving techniques, regulations & permits) and the 3 hour road test (including LCV driving and coupling/uncoupling equipment).
Road tests are booked by appointment and must be completed within 30 days of taking the LCV course

Fees
MTA members: \$150.00 classroom + \$175.00 road test (plus GST) = \$157.50 (classroom)//\$183.75 (road test)
Non-members: \$250.00 classroom + \$275.00 road test (plus GST) = \$262.50 (classroom)//\$288.75 (road test)

NEW: REGISTRATION & CANCELLATION POLICY

1. Course registration will close one week (five business days) prior to the course date.
2. Payment must be made in full prior to the class in order to be considered registered for it. Payment can be made by credit card, cash or cheque. Members in good standing can continue to be invoiced for courses; however, the cancellation policy will still apply.
3. All cancellations must be received by the MTA office, either in writing or by phone, one week (five business days) prior to the course date in order to receive a full refund.
4. Any cancellations that occur within one week (five business days) of the course date are subject to a 50% cancellation fee.
5. Any cancellations that occur within 48 hours (two business days) of the course date are subject to a 100% cancellation fee.
