



2010 Manitoba Professional Truck Driving Championship

Saturday, June 26, 2010

Who can enter?

Any city or highway driver employed by a common, contract, specialized or private Carrier Company, whose **primary responsibility is driving** and who has been accident-free for the past 12 months. Drivers must be permanent residents of Manitoba or domiciled here, and may not have driven for more than 2 companies in the past 12 months.

How much does it cost?

The cost is \$140 plus GST per driver for MTA Member companies, and \$170 plus GST for non-member companies. Two tickets for the Awards Banquet are included in the registration fee.

What are the Classes of Competition?

2-axle Straight Truck
5-axle Tandem/Tandem

3-axle Single/Single
8-axle Super B Train

4-axle Single/Tandem
Step Van

How many drivers can one company enter?

A Company may enter a maximum of 12 drivers with no more than 2 in any one class.
No driver may compete in more than one class.

What is required for a team entry?

A team consists of 4 to 6 drivers, entered in at least 4 classes of competition. Companies may enter a maximum of 2 teams. Drivers from different employers may enter as a team.
Team members must be listed on the Entry Form at the time of registration. No changes in team personnel are permitted.

How do I enter?

Mail the completed Entry Form *and* your Driver's Abstract dated not prior to May 14, 2010 *and* the signed Declaration/ Release form *and* the Entry Fee to:

What happens after I register?

The MTA will provide you with a Drivers Kit containing all the information you need including details of the field test, course obstacles, circle check inspection, and written tests. You will also receive a detailed schedule for the day and 2 tickets for the Drivers Awards Banquet.

Where and when is the Drivers Awards Banquet?

The Awards Banquet will be held that evening at the Canad Inns Polo Park in Winnipeg. Your registration includes 2 banquet tickets. Additional tickets may be purchased from the MTA at \$65 plus GST.

The evening will include good food, great fellowship and, of course, award presentations to the Championships winners. Additional presentations include Manitoba's "2010 Driver of the Year".

What prizes are available?

For each Class, trophies are awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. In addition there are awards for the top Team, the Grand Champion and top First-Time Entrant.

What happens if I win?

The winner in each class will get to showcase their skills in front of a hometown crowd as we gear up to host the **2010 National Professional Truck Driving Championship** this year, September 16-19!
