MTA members [TruckDown](#) would like to remind members of their services: [TruckDown.com](#) is a vendor locator used by the commercial trucking industry to locate and contact vendors throughout Canada and the USA. The service has over 40,000 heavy truck service vendors in the network including truck stops, heavy truck repair shops, heavy wrecker services, mobile tire and mechanical repair services, scales and more. Vendor listings include whether or not the location is open. The service is free to use for commercial fleets.

Helpful Hint: When searching on TruckDown every vendor location has a link called “Report a Location Update” that can be used to report the need to update location information. The TruckDown team follows up on all reports by contacting the vendor. Reporting location updates helps all fleets by keeping information accurate.

Groceries
